Tuition Approach

For English as a Foreign Language tuition, my approach with tutoring is always to structure the learning around the exams in question (where exams are being taken), working with the students to identify gaps in their knowledge in relation to the syllabus, and/or areas they feel they need to improve upon. With a lot of students, gaining confidence is half the battle - by tailoring lessons specifically to exam and syllabus requirements, I aim to help the students feel comfortable and relaxed when faced with the actual exam paper.
